The **Senior and Special Need Advocacy Program (SSNAP)** provides for older Dobermans and those with medical or behavioral issues who can be shelter residents for a long time. These dogs are typically overlooked by prospective adopters and **SSNAP** allows them the care and time needed to find that special someone.

SSNAP dogs often have the added expense of medication, special diet, supplements, training, etc. **SSNAP** spotlights these dogs with the hope of ultimately finding a permanent home for each one. All **SSNAP** donations are used to provide ongoing, supportive care for these wonderful dogs.
